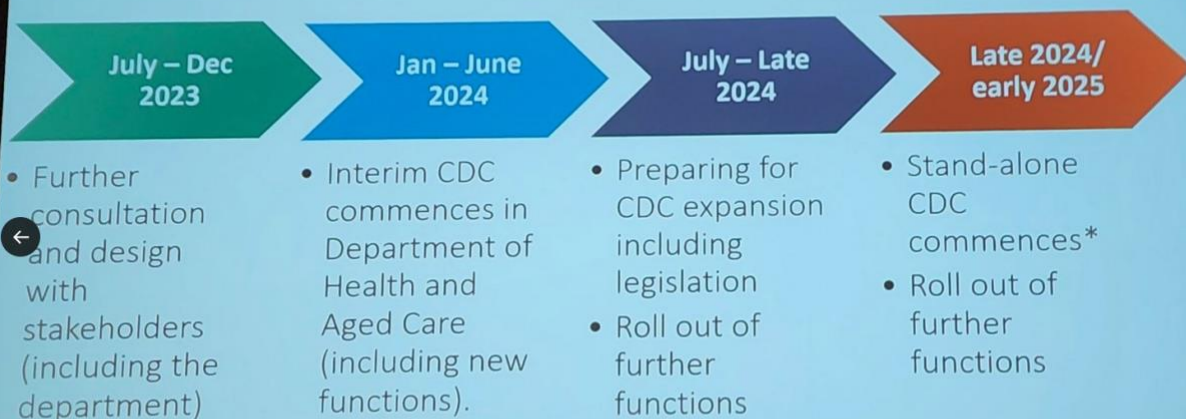
## CDC OBJECTIVES

- 05** Increase resources to improve preparedness and response

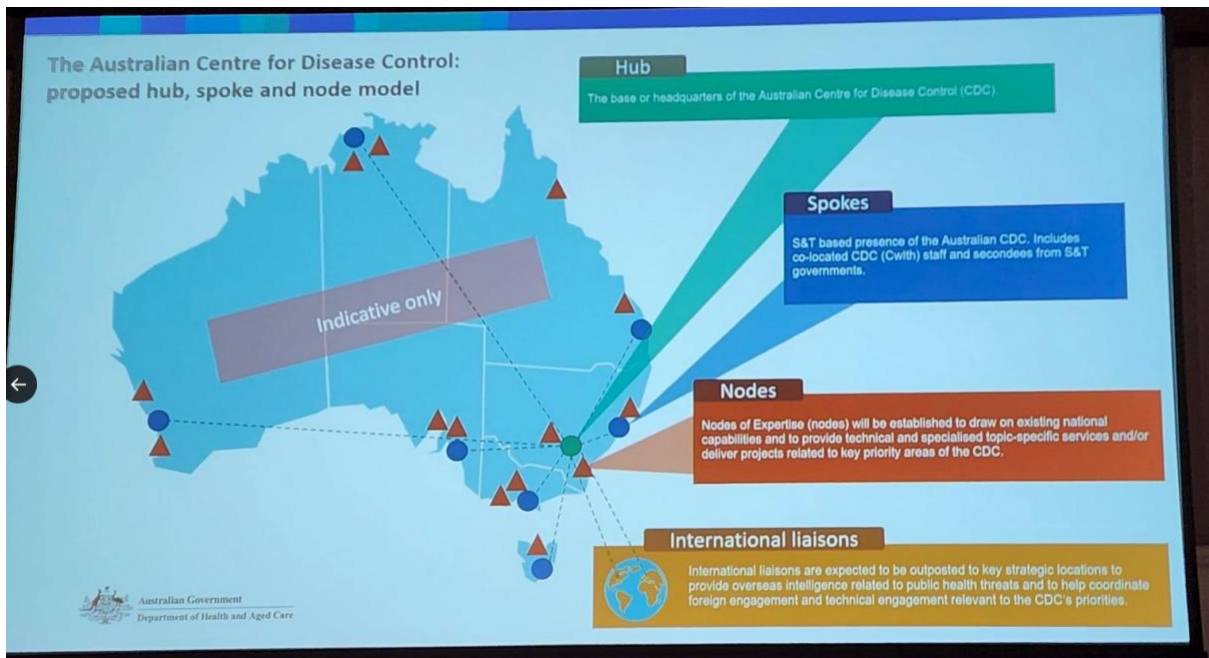

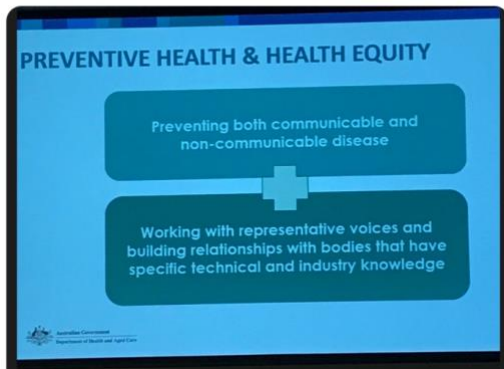
